Today, the shamrock and the colour green have become symbols of St. Patrick's Day. On Saint Patrick's Day many people wear green clothes and shamrocks.

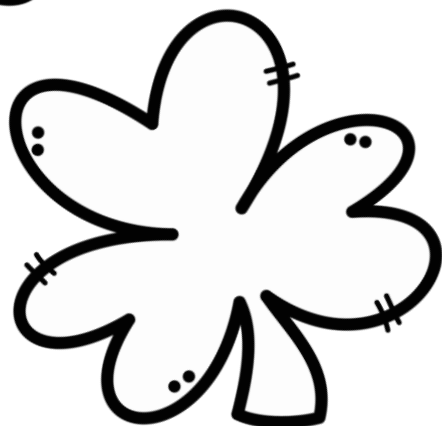
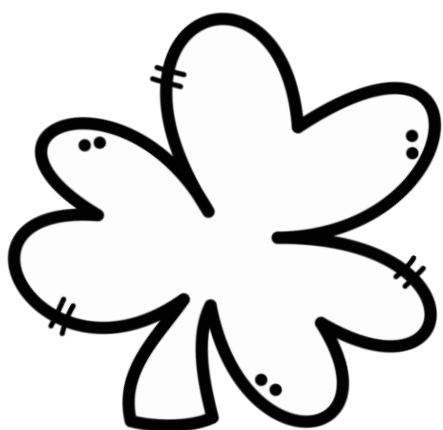

He has a red beard and wears a green coat and hat.

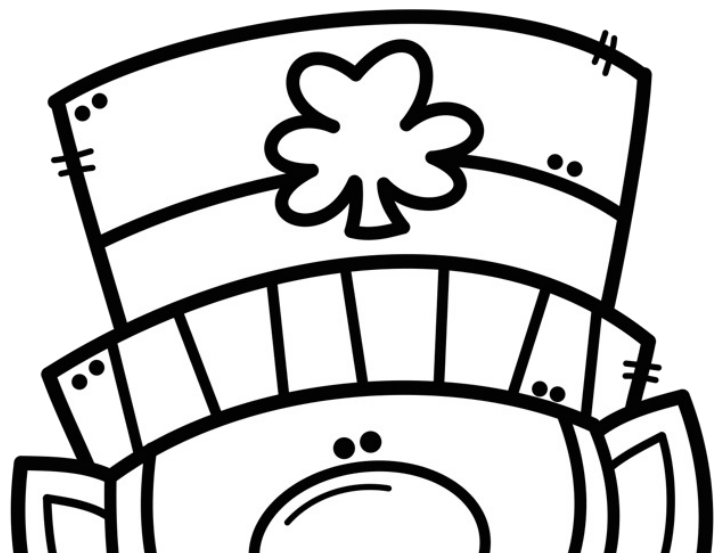
A leprechaun very naughty and sneaky.

It said, that leprechauns guard hidden pots of gold.

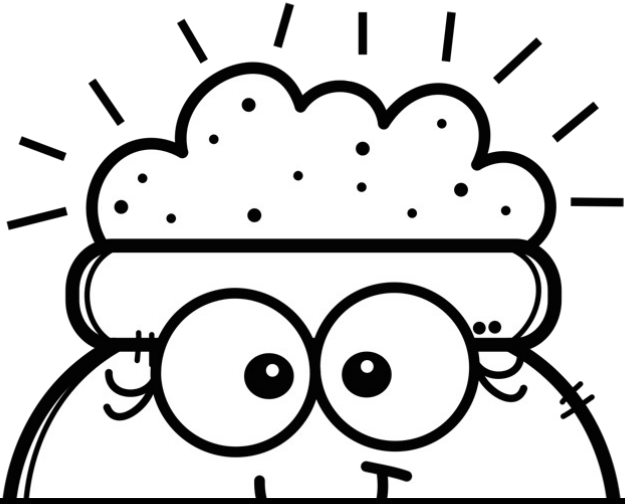
If you catch a leprechaun, he will give you his pot of gold.

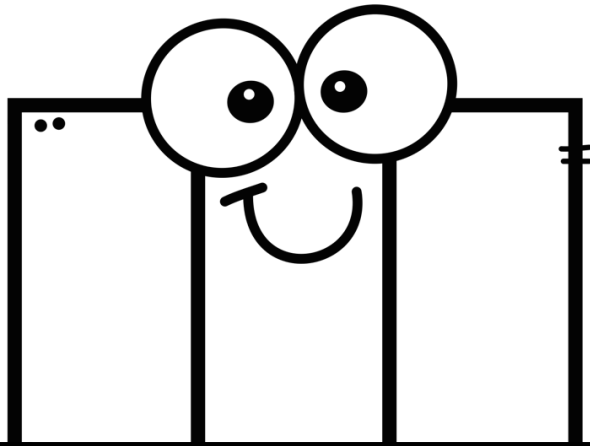
